Step 1: Prerequisites

Step 3: Licensing and initial configuration

Following the successful deployment of GFI ClearView, you will need to share the unique HostID of the appliance with your regional channel account manager. This HostID is crucial for activating the trial license. Additionally, before or after license activation, the initial configuration steps must be executed. These steps encompass:

- Ensuring internet access for the management interface.
- Configuring traffic mirroring from the switch to the GFI ClearView host.
- Defining network subnets within the GFI ClearView interface.
- Enabling the Mirroring option on the NIC responsible for mirrored traffic in the GFI ClearView WebUI.

Once the license is enabled, you can verify the successful copying of traffic to the GFI ClearView appliance through the Monitor > Real-time section.

(Let up the initial configuration process typically takes under 30 minutes.)

Step 4: Evaluation

With the deployment and initial configuration completed, it's time to allow the GFI ClearView appliance to collect data over one week. During this period, you can schedule hourly and daily reports to assess user behavior, network usage, and emerging trends within the network.

After the trial, you can create a custom-built report or utilize the raw reports from GFI ClearView, along with remarks to effectively summarize the trial findings.
